

ORDINANCE NO. 55 -92

An Ordinance to appropriate funds in the amount of \$85,000.00 from the Sewer Fund for the purchase of a sewer flusher and easement machine and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$85,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the Sewer Fund to purchase a sewer flusher and easement machine.

Section 2. That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into a contract for the purchase of a sewer flusher and easement machine.

Section 3. That the contract authorized herein shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety in order to commence improvements at the earliest possible date and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
