An Ordinance to appropriate the amount of \$1,500.00 from the Water Fund for the purpose of testing for lead and copper in drinking water as mandated by the United States Environmental Protection Agency and to declare an emergency.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$1,500.00 be, and it hereby is, appropriated and set aside from the Water Fund for the purpose of testing for lead and copper in drinking water.


Section 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to report test results prior to January 10, 1993, and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
