An Ordinance to authorize the Mayor and Auditor to enter into a lease-purchase agreement for equipment to upgrade the City's 9-1-1 system, to appropriate \$427.79 from the unencumbered General Fund the first month's lease payment and to declare an emergency. *L for*

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to enter into a lease-purchase agreement for equipment to upgrade the City's 9-1-1 system with Ameritech Credit Corporation.

Section 2. That a copy of said agreement is attached to this Ordinance and incorporated herein and made a part hereof as if fully rewritten.

Section 3. That \$427.79 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund to pay the first month's lease payment.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety in order to assure uninterrupted operation of the City's 9-1-1 system, and this ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
