## ORDINANCE NO. 69-92

An Ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 14-92 to authorize the position of Grounds Maintenance Supervisor (Jeffrey Mansion), to authorize a second position of Secretary to the Recreation Department, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1: That the listing of full-time salaried employees at Schedule II is hereby amended by the addition of the following:

GROUNDS MAINTENANCE SUPERVISOR (JEFFREY MANSION)

\$14,175 - \$27,562

Section 2: That the fourth and fifth paragraphs of Schedule II is hereby amended to read as follows:

A. The Secretary to the Service Department, Secretary to the Building Department, SECRETARIES (2) to the Recreation Department, Secretary to the Police Department, Clerk of Courts/Administrative Aide to the Chief of Police, and Water Department Account Clerk 2, will be paid annual salaries based on the stated years of continuous employment as a full-time employee as follows:

Starting	Rate	\$16,040
After 1st	year	\$19,148
After 2nd	year	\$20,861
After 3rd	year	\$23,505

The Receptionist/Secretary (CITY HALL) will be paid an annual salary based on the stated years of continuous employment as follows:

Starting Rate			\$13,371
After	lst	year	\$15,108
After	2nd	year	\$16,844
After	3rd	year	\$18,999

Section 3: That, as amended hereby, the rates of pay shall be as set forth in Ordinance No. 14-92.

Section 4: That this ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, in order to assure interrupted City services in the Recreation Department, and this Ordinance shall go into force and effect on January 1, 1993, following its passage and approval by the Mayor.
