

ORDINANCE NO. 71 -92

An Ordinance to amend Section 1430.02(a)(2) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Bexley to increase plumbing permit fees charged by the Bexley Building Department and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1: That Section 1430.02(a)(2) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Bexley be amended to read as follows:

(2) Plumbing permits There shall be a fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) for the first fixture or opening plus ~~five~~ SIX dollars (~~\$5.00~~) (\$6.00) for each additional opening or fixture. Permits for alterations or repairs to any sanitary plumbing system shall be computed at the same rate.

Section 2: That the existing Section 1430.02(a)(2) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Bexley is hereby repealed.

Section 3: That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to establish fees that are uniform with the Franklin County General Health District, and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
