

SUBSTITUTE ORDINANCE NO. 6-93

An Ordinance to transfer \$1,500.00 from the unencumbered General Fund to the Capital Improvements Fund, to appropriate \$1,500.00 from the Capital Improvements Fund for the purpose of paying additional costs for the remodeling of the outdoor restroom facility in Jeffrey Park, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That \$1,500.00 is hereby transferred from the unencumbered General Fund to the Capital Improvements Fund.

Section 2. That \$1,500.00 is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvements Fund for the purpose of additional costs for remodeling of the outdoor restroom facility in Jeffrey Park.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the necessity of completing the public restroom facilities at the earliest practicable date, which shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
