

ORDINANCE NO. 11-93

An Ordinance to appropriate \$10,000.00 from the unencumbered General Fund to Account Number 21-330-137.1, S.B.A. Tree Program, for the purpose of paying the City of Bexley's share of a tree planting grant, and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, the City has been awarded a \$5,000.00 National Small Business Tree Planting grant from the Ohio Department of Natural Resources; and,

WHEREAS, the City is required to match the grant with an equal amount. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the amount of \$10,000.00 should be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund to Account Number 21-330-137.1, S.B.A. Tree Program.

Section 2. That the Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the tree planting program with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law.

Section 3. That upon completion of the tree planting program, the City will be reimbursed by the Ohio Department of Natural Resources in the amount of \$5,000.00.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to proceed with a contract prior to the Spring planting season, and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
