

ORDINANCE NO. 18 -93

An Ordinance to appropriate \$40,000 from the unencumbered Capital Improvements Fund to pay the costs of purchasing a replacement truck for the aerial lift truck which was destroyed by fire, to authorize the Mayor and Auditor to enter into a contract for the truck and to declare an emergency. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:


Section 1. That the sum of \$40,000 should be, and it hereby is, appropriated from the unencumbered Capital Improvements Fund to pay the cost of the purchase of an aerial lift truck to replace one destroyed by fire.

Section 2. That the Mayor and Auditor are authorized to enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement and bidding in accordance with law.


Section 3. Any insurance payments made to the City will be used to reimburse the Capital Improvements Fund.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need for an aerial lift truck to repair City street and traffic lights, and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.


