

ORDINANCE NO. 39 -93

An Ordinance to appropriate \$65,000.00 from the General Fund to the Street Fund for the purpose of repairing sections of brick paving on North Roosevelt Avenue between Broad Street and Maryland Avenue and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the amount of \$65,000.00 should be, and it hereby is, appropriated from the General Fund to the Street Fund for the purpose of repairing sections of brick paving on North Roosevelt Avenue between Broad Street and Maryland Avenue.

Section 2. That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed, after advertisement in accordance with law, to enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to restore North Roosevelt Avenue pavement to a sound condition at the earliest possible date, and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
