

ORDINANCE NO. 63-93

An Ordinance consenting, pursuant to Section 406.04 of the Codified Ordinances, to the designation by the Mayor of the alley directly south of East Main Street between Vernon Road and South Remington Road as one-way moving west and between Vernon Road and South Roosevelt Avenue as one-way heading east and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That this Council hereby consents, pursuant to Section 406.04 of the Codified Ordinances, to the designation by the Mayor of the alley directly south of East Main Street between Vernon Road and South Remington Road as one-way heading west and between Vernon Road and South Roosevelt Avenue as one-way headed east.

Section 2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to place and maintain appropriate markings, signs, barriers or other devices to give notice of the one-way designations for which consent has been granted in Section 1 hereof.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency ordinance, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to minimize the risk of injury to persons and property presented by current two-way traffic conditions in the alley between South Remington Road and South Roosevelt Avenue, and this Ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect on its passage and approval by the Mayor.
