

RESOLUTION NO. 2 -94

A Resolution authorizing the Mayor and Auditor to file a grant application with the Ohio Department of Transportation for the purpose of acquiring funds for the landscaping of Drexel Circle.

WHEREAS, the Intermodal Surface Transportation Efficiency Act of 1991 (ISTEA) established funds for Transportation Enhancement Activities including Historic Site Enhancement, Scenic and Environmental Enhancement, and Pedestrian and Bicycle Facilities; and,

WHEREAS, the landscaping of Drexel Circle is an eligible project. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Council of the City of Bexley hereby authorizes the Mayor and Auditor to file a grant application with the Ohio Department of Transportation for the purpose of acquiring funds for the landscaping of Drexel Circle.

Section 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and related to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. That this Resolution is an emergency Resolution necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to proceed with the grant application to meet specific deadlines, and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
