

ORDINANCE NO. 8 -94

An Ordinance to appropriate \$75,000 from the Capital Improvements Fund for the purchase of computer hardware and software for various City departments and related installation, training and maintenance services, to authorize the Mayor and Auditor to execute contracts with respect thereto and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That \$75,000 is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvements Fund for the purchase of computer hardware and software for various City departments and related installation, training and maintenance services.

Section 2. That the Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized and directed to enter into agreements for the purchase of the computer hardware and software and related services specified in Section 1, said contracts to be in form and substance acceptable to the City Attorney.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the necessity to complete the computerization of various City departments at the earliest possible date, and this Ordinance shall go into force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
