

ORDINANCE NO. 10 -94

An Ordinance to authorize the Mayor and Auditor to execute an agreement with Denham L. Pride.

WHEREAS, Denham L. Pride, an independent governmental affairs consultant, conducts audits of Bureau of Motor Vehicles records to determine the registration of vehicles incorrectly allocated to the City of Columbus; and,

WHEREAS, Denham L. Pride has proposed providing this service to the City of Bexley, Ohio; and,

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Bexley to determine when Bexley vehicle registrations are incorrectly allocated to the City of Columbus. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the agreement with Denham L. Pride is hereby approved in the form attached to this Ordinance and that the Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement on behalf of the City.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect at the earliest period allowed by law.

## A G R E E M E N T

This Agreement provides for Denham L. Pride, an independent governmental affairs consultant, to conduct an audit of certain Bureau of Motor Vehicles records, for and on behalf of the City of Bexley, Ohio.

The scope of the audit will be as follows:

- The Bureau of Motor Vehicles records of taxing district No. 2504, City of Columbus, will be audited and all registrations of Bexley residents and business establishments that have been incorrectly allocated to the City of Columbus will be recorded on the prescribed forms.
- A copy of all incorrect registrations that have been allocated to the City of Columbus will be transmitted to said City of Columbus for their review and challenge within the 30 day period as required.
- A copy of all incorrect registrations, after the 30 day challenge period has expired, will be forwarded to the Bureau of Motor Vehicles in order that the appropriate corrections can be made.

Denham L. Pride will assume the cost of purchasing computer printouts from the Bureau of Motor Vehicles, will conduct the audit, and will deliver the copy of the Audit Findings Report Forms to the City of Columbus and to the Bureau of Motor Vehicles.


The City of Bexley will provide a current Bexley street map, a complete listing of all public and private streets in alphabetical order, beginning and ending house numbers on all streets that border or cross over into another political subdivision, and all applicable zip codes.


The City of Bexley will pay Denham L. Pride the sum of two dollars and forty cents (\$2.40) for each incorrect motor vehicle registration forwarded to the Bureau of Motor Vehicles for correction and adjustment.


The City of Bexley, Ohio will pay Denham L. Pride the sum of Two Dollars and Forty Cents (\$2.40) for each challenged registration that has to be withdrawn because of faulty, incorrect, or incomplete street listings and house numbers as supplied by the City of Bexley to Denham L. Pride.

The City of Bexley wishes to have the months of January through December, 1993, audited pursuant to this agreement.
