

ORDINANCE NO. 11-94

An Ordinance to authorize the Mayor to sell: one 1982 GMC Packer, one 1987 GMC Packer, one 1985 Cushman, two 1988 Cushmans, one Eager Beaver compartmentalized recycling trailer with plastic compactor, and one Eager Beaver compartmentalized recycling trailer to the highest and best bidder and to declare an emergency.

Section 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 721.15 to sell: one 1982 GMC Packer, one 1987 GMC Packer, one 1985 Cushman, two 1988 Cushmans, one Eager Beaver compartmentalized recycling trailer with plastic compactor, one Eager Beaver compartmentalized recycling trailer, all of which are deemed to be surplus property not needed for municipal purposes.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to seek bids and dispose of surplus equipment, and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
