ORDINANCE NO. /4 -94

An Ordinance to establish the compensation of the City Attorney for 1994 and to appropriate \$75,000 from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying the fees and expenses of the City Attorney during such period.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the City Attorney shall be paid a retainer of \$30,000 and expenses plus fees at the hourly rate for the lawyer performing services with respect to representation of the City before the Bexley Mayor's Court, and the Bexley Civil Service Commission and in other legal proceedings. Fees shall be paid monthly or at the discretion of the City Auditor. The fee arrangement set forth herein does not include representation of the Bexley School District. Until and unless changed, other benefits of the City Attorney shall be as set forth in Ordinance No. 15-90, as amended in part by Ordinance No. 49-90.

Section 2. That \$75,000 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund to the following accounts for the purpose of paying the fees and expenses of the City Attorney:

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect on the earliest date permitted by law; provided, however, that the compensation and benefits provided herein shall be payable from and after January 1, 1994.
