

ORDINANCE NO. 18-94

An Ordinance to appropriate Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000.00) from the Swimming Pool Fund for renovation of the deck area and the painting of the main pool and baby pool, to authorize the Mayor and Auditor to enter into contracts for such projects, to ratify certain actions taken in bidding the deck renovation project and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000.00) is hereby appropriated from the Swimming Pool Fund for renovation of the deck area and the painting of the main pool and baby pool.

Section 2. That the Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized and directed to enter into contracts for the projects authorized by Section 1 and that such contracts, when required by law, shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law.

Section 3. That all actions taken by the City administration in advertising and bidding the deck renovation project prior to the date of this Ordinance are hereby ratified, confirmed and approved by and on behalf of the City.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to complete capital improvements and maintenance at the Bexley pool prior to May 28, 1994, which shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
