

ORDINANCE NO. 20 -94

An Ordinance to authorize the purchase of an unmarked police vehicle to be assigned to the Chief of Police from funds appropriated by Ordinance No. 25-93 and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized and directed to purchase an unmarked police vehicle to be assigned to the Chief of Police from funds appropriated by Ordinance No. 25-93.

Section 2. That all actions taken by the City administration in connection with the purchase authorized by Section 1 prior to the date of this Ordinance are hereby ratified, confirmed and approved by and on behalf of the City.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to assure that a full complement of police vehicles is operational, which shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
