

ORDINANCE NO. 22-94

An Ordinance to amend section 1060.09 and repeal section 1060.11 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Bexley regarding charges and authorization for trash collection and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That section 1060.09 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Bexley be amended to read as follows:

1060.09 AUTHORIZATION FOR TRASH COLLECTION AND LICENSING OF HAULERS.

(a) The Mayor shall through the Department of Public Service, collect and dispose of all garbage, trash, recyclables, yard waste and brush ~~accumulating on premises used for dwelling purposes~~ FROM RESIDENTIAL CONDOMINIUM UNITS, SINGLE-FAMILY, TWO-FAMILY AND MULTI-FAMILY DWELLINGS CONSISTING OF EIGHT OR FEWER UNITS in the City, provided, however, that he shall not be required to remove the same if the foregoing provisions as to receptacles and deposit of refuse have not been complied with ~~and provided, further, that nothing herein shall prevent an owner, tenant, lessee or occupant of premises from removing or employing others to remove the same from the premises owned or occupied by him. However, any person regularly so employed to remove the same shall be licensed by the City.~~

Section 2. That existing Section 1060.09 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Bexley should be, and it hereby is, repealed.

Section 3. That existing Section 1060.11 of the Codified Ordinances regarding charges to schools and commercial establishments should be, and it hereby is, repealed in it's entirety.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to comply with the existing sanitation contract, and shall go into effect upon it's passage and approval by the Mayor.
