An Ordinance to amend Sections 1062.11 and 1062.31 of the Codified Ordinances to clarify the authority of the Mayor to make and enforce traffic regulations within City Parks and the Recreation Board and Recreation Director to adopt and enforce rules governing the use of City Parks and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 1062.11 is hereby amended as follows:

1062.11 Speed Limits TRAFFIC CONTROL.

No person shall drive upon any park road at a rate of speed exceeding ten miles per hour or the posted speed. THE MAYOR IS HEREBY AUTHORIZED TO MAKE AND ENFORCE TRAFFIC REGULATIONS WITHIN THE PARKS AND TO ERECT TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES TO REGULATE TRAFFIC AND PROMOTE PUBLIC SAFETY THEREIN, AND NO PERSON SHALL FAIL TO OBEY ANY SUCH TRAFFIC REGULATIONS OR DEVICES, INCLUDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNALS, SIGNS OR MARKERS, CROSSWALKS OR MARKS OR LINES UPON THE SURFACE OF A ROADWAY.

Section 2. That Section 1062.31 is hereby amended as follows:

1062.31 Waiver of OTHER PARK regulations.

THE RECREATION BOARD OR THE RECREATION DIRECTOR MAY ADOPT ADDITIONAL RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE USE OF THE PARKS, AND NO PERSON SHALL FAIL TO OBEY ANY SUCH RULE OR REGULATION WHICH IS POSTED. The Recreation Board may waive any of the provisions of this chapter, EXCEPT TRAFFIC REGULATIONS PROMULGATED UNDER SECTION 1062.11, for special events or occasions.

Section 3. That existing Sections 1062.11 and 1062.31 is are hereby repealed.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to assure the enforceability of traffic and other regulations in City Parks, and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
