

ORDINANCE NO. 45 -94

An Ordinance to transfer the sum of \$5,500.00 from the unencumbered General Fund to the Capital Improvements Fund and appropriate the same amount for the purpose of purchasing play equipment for Schneider Park and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That \$5,500.00 is hereby transferred from the unencumbered General Fund to the Capital Improvements Fund.

Section 2. That \$5,500.00 is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvements Fund for the purchase of play equipment at Schneider Park.

Section 3. That the Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized and directed to enter into contracts for the purchase of play equipment authorized by Section 2 hereof.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to complete installation of the equipment during the renovation of Schneider Park, and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
