

ORDINANCE NO. 46 -94

An Ordinance to transfer the sum of \$14,000.00 from the unencumbered General Fund to the Capital Improvements Fund and appropriate \$14,000.00 from the Capital Improvements Fund for the purpose of paying for additional work needed to pave Ashbourne Road and Ashbourne Place, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$23,000.00 was previously appropriated in Ordinance No. 27-94 for the purpose of paving Ashbourne Road and Ashbourne Place.

Section 2. That the total cost for the project is \$36,551.00, and that the additional sum of \$14,000.00 should be, and it hereby is, transferred from the unencumbered General Fund to the Capital Improvements Fund and appropriated from the Capital Improvements Fund for the purpose of paying for the additional work needed to pave Ashbourne Road and Ashbourne Place.

Section 3. That the Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized and directed to enter into contracts for the project authorized by Section 2 hereof and that such contracts, when required by law, shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to complete the paving during the 1994 construction season, and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
