

SUBSTITUTE ORDINANCE NO. 58 -94

An Ordinance to appropriate \$146,411 from the unencumbered General Fund, \$2,300 from the Street Maintenance and Repair Fund, \$9,200 from the Recreation Fund and \$9,400 from the Swimming Pool Fund to pay various operating expenses of the City for the current fiscal year.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1: That \$146,411 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund as follows:


