

ORDINANCE NO. 63 -94

An Ordinance to authorize the Mayor and Auditor to execute an agreement with Denham L. Pride.

WHEREAS, Denham L. Pride, an independent governmental affairs consultant, conducts audits of Bureau of Motor Vehicles records to determine the registration of vehicles incorrectly allocated to the City of Columbus; and,

WHEREAS, Denham L. Pride has proposed providing this service to the City of Bexley, Ohio; and,

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Bexley to determine when Bexley vehicle registrations are incorrectly allocated to the City of Columbus. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the agreement with Denham L. Pride is hereby approved in the form attached to this Ordinance and that the Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement on behalf of the City.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and affect at the earliest period allowed by law.

AGREEMENT
BUREAU OF MOTOR VEHICLES TAXING DISTRICT AUDIT

This Agreement authorizes Denham Pride, an independent governmental affairs consultant, to conduct an audit of certain Ohio Bureau of Motor Vehicles records for, and on behalf of, Bexley, Franklin County, Ohio. The audit will include the following:

The Bureau of Motor Vehicles records of taxing district No. 2504, City of Columbus, Ohio, will be audited and all registrations of Bexley residents and business establishments that have been incorrectly allocated to the City of Columbus, Ohio, will be recorded on the prescribed forms.

A copy of all incorrect registrations that have been incorrectly allocated to the City of Columbus, Ohio, will be transmitted to said political subdivision for their review and challenge within the thirty day period, as required.

After the thirty day challenge period has expired, a copy of all incorrect registrations will be forwarded to the Bureau of Motor Vehicles where the appropriate corrections and adjustments will be made.

Denham Pride will assume the expense of purchasing the necessary computer printouts from the Bureau of Motor Vehicles, will conduct the audit, and will deliver the copy of the "Taxing District/Township Audit Findings Report" forms to the City of Columbus, Ohio, and to the Bureau of Motor Vehicles.


The City of Bexley, Ohio, will provide a current street map, a current and complete listing of all public and private streets (in alphabetical order), beginning and ending numbers and odd/even house numbers on all streets that border or continue into another political subdivision, a listing of all applicable zip codes, and all necessary photocopying services.

The City of Bexley, Ohio, will pay Denham Pride the sum of Two Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$2.50) for each incorrect motor vehicle license registration forwarded to the Bureau of Motor Vehicles for correction and adjustment.

The City of Bexley, Ohio, will pay Denham Pride the sum of Two Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$2.50) for each challenged registration that has to be withdrawn because of faulty, incorrect, or incomplete street listings and house numbers as supplied by this political subdivision to Denham Pride.


The City of Bexley, Ohio, wishes to have the months of January through December, 1994, audited pursuant to this Agreement.

This Agreement is entered into this 10 th day of January, 1995.
