

RESOLUTION NO. 9-95

A Resolution in support of the passage of State Issue 2.

WHEREAS, Issue 2 renews the successful State Capital Improvements Program, which won over 70 percent of voters' approval in 1987 and will allow Ohio communities to address nearly \$17 billion in road, bridge, water, wastewater, stormwater, and solid waste needs; and,

WHEREAS, this local/state government partnership is well developed, with over 5,000 completed projects in every corner of the state; and,

WHEREAS, in its first eight years, the program has distributed more than \$997 million in bond proceeds to local governments for improvements to roads and bridges, wastewater treatment facilities, water supply and flood control systems, stormwater and sanitary collection facilities, and solid waste water systems; and,

WHEREAS, Issue 2 has benefited the City of Bexley by providing \$469,344 for needed street and water system improvements; and,

WHEREAS, Issue 2 will allow badly needed state highway projects to move forward; and,

WHEREAS, Issue 2 will help retain jobs rebuilding Ohio's infrastructure and keep Ohio companies competitive; and,

WHEREAS, said investment will help local communities improve the quality of life for all Ohioans without raising taxes. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That this Council endorses State Issue 2, the State Capital Improvements Program.

Section 2. That this Resolution shall go into effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
