

ORDINANCE NO. 20-95

An Ordinance to authorize the Mayor and Auditor to enter into a contract on behalf of the City of Bexley for the Mosquito Adulticiding and Larviciding Program services for the year 1995, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract on behalf of the City of Bexley for the Mosquito Adulticiding and Larviciding Program services for the year 1995, in such terms as shall be approved by the City Health Commissioner and the City Attorney.

Section 2. That the contract authorized herein, when required by law, shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the necessity to begin the program prior to the onset of warm weather, and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.

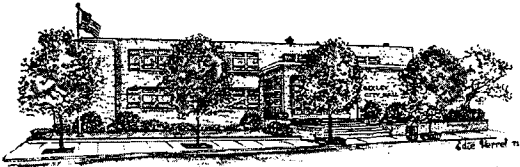

## ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed proposals will be received and publically opened by the Mayor of the City of Bexley, Ohio, 2242 East Main Street, Bexley, Ohio, 11:00 A.M., May 1, 1995, for the following:

1. Providing a mosquito adulticiding program for the City of Bexley for the period of May 29, 1995 to October 1, 1995 (the maximum time period).
2. Providing a mosquito larviciding program for the City of Bexley, as needed, during the time specified in No. 1 above.

All of the above listed services and materials must comply with the Ohio Department of Agriculture rules and regulations for application of pesticides. Specifications and proposal blanks may be obtained in the Mayor's Office of the City of Bexley, 2242 East Main Street, Bexley, Ohio.

Bidders must bid all items.

The City reserves the right to increase the amount, type, and method of dispersal of the materials used during the 1995 calendar year, and may increase or decrease the adulticiding or larviciding frequency as public health concerns warrant.

Each proposal shall contain the full name of every person, firm, or corporation interested in same and shall be accompanied by a certified or cashier's check on a solvent bank of Ohio in the amount of Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00), payable to the Auditor of the City of Bexley, Ohio, as a guarantee that if the bid is accepted, a contract will be entered into and its performance properly secured, with the exception that a governmental agency need not secure their bid. Should any bids be rejected, such checks will be returned upon proper execution of the contract. Otherwise, the same will be retained by the City if said condition is not fulfilled.

The right is reserved to reject any and all bids.

Envelopes should be plainly marked: "Bids for Mosquito Program".

## SPECIFICATIONS

### FOR MOSQUITO PROGRAM

- 1995 -

### CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO

#### 1. ADULTICIDING PROGRAM

This item will comply with current Ohio Department of Agriculture safe pesticide application procedures. Specifications call for the spraying of the entire City of Bexley over a ten day period, with a prescheduled route to accomplish this. Applicants must own three "London Fog" or "Leco" type truck mounted ULV (ultra low volume) applicators and a backup unit of the same type, as the applicants must be able to spray the entire city in a 24 hour period in an emergency. Applicant must be able to adjust spraying schedule to account for inclement weather. Applicant will spray with Malathion (technical grade) to kill adult mosquitoes. Bid will cover ULV application of Malathion, including all materials, vehicles, equipment, and personnel time at an hourly rate, and successful bidder must furnish proof of possession of the required ULV units. Approximate area to be sprayed: 2.5 square miles.

#### 2. LARVICIDING PROGRAM

This item will comply with current Ohio Department of Agriculture safe pesticide application procedures. Specifications call for the spraying of all catch basins in the City of Bexley on demand by the Health Commissioner or the Mayor of Bexley. Applicants must own a "London Fog" type spray converter or a back pack unit capable of spraying several hundred storm sewer catch basins and spraying wooded areas where needed. Applicants will spray with Malathion (technical grade), or use other suitable larvicides to kill the immature mosquitoes. Approximate frequency: twice. Area is not known. Bid will cover ULV application of Malathion or other suitable larvicide, including all materials, vehicles, equipment, and personnel time at an hourly rate, and successful bidder must furnish proof of possession of the required units.

\*\* The City of Bexley reserves the right to increase or decrease the frequency of treatment of both programs. All areas and numbers are estimates only.

Each bid must state the qualifications of the company to provide service under this contract. It is important that the City receive timely service on both of these programs, as they have serious Public Health implications. This factor will be given consideration in the award of this contract.





ATTENTION BIDDERS

SECTION 5719.042 - The Ohio Revised Code. After the award by a taxing district of any contract let by competitive bid and prior to the time the contract is entered into, the person making the bid shall submit to the district's fiscal officer a statement affirmed under oath that the person with whom the contract is to be made was not charged at the time the bid was submitted with any delinquent property taxes on any such tax list, in which case the statement shall also set forth the amount of such due and unpaid delinquent taxes and any due and unpaid penalties and interest thereon. If the statement indicates that the taxpayer was charged with any such taxes, a copy of the statement shall be transmitted by the fiscal officer to the county treasurer within thirty days of the date it is submitted.

A copy of the statement shall also be incorporated into the contract, and no payment shall be made with respect to any contract to which this section applies unless such statement has been so incorporated as a part thereof.
