

AMENDED ORDINANCE NO. 21 -95

An Ordinance to repeal Ordinance No. 41-92 which permitted construction of a fence in the City-owned unimproved alley right-of-way running between Caroline Avenue on the south and the municipal corporation line on the north and between the City-owned tree nursery on the west and North Columbia Avenue on the east, as shown on the attached map.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 41-92 granted permission to Jaime and Matilde E. Pardo, property owners at 2364 Caroline Avenue (Lot Nos. 10, 11, 12 and part of 13; Bexley Heights Addition) to construct a six foot high wood privacy fence in the City-owned alley right-of-way as described above; and,

WHEREAS, the fence was not constructed by Jaime and Matilde E. Pardo, but was constructed by Cathleen M. and Rahman Bahrami, property owners at 555 North Columbia Avenue as approved by Ordinance No. 23 -95. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 41-92 should be, and hereby is, repealed.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

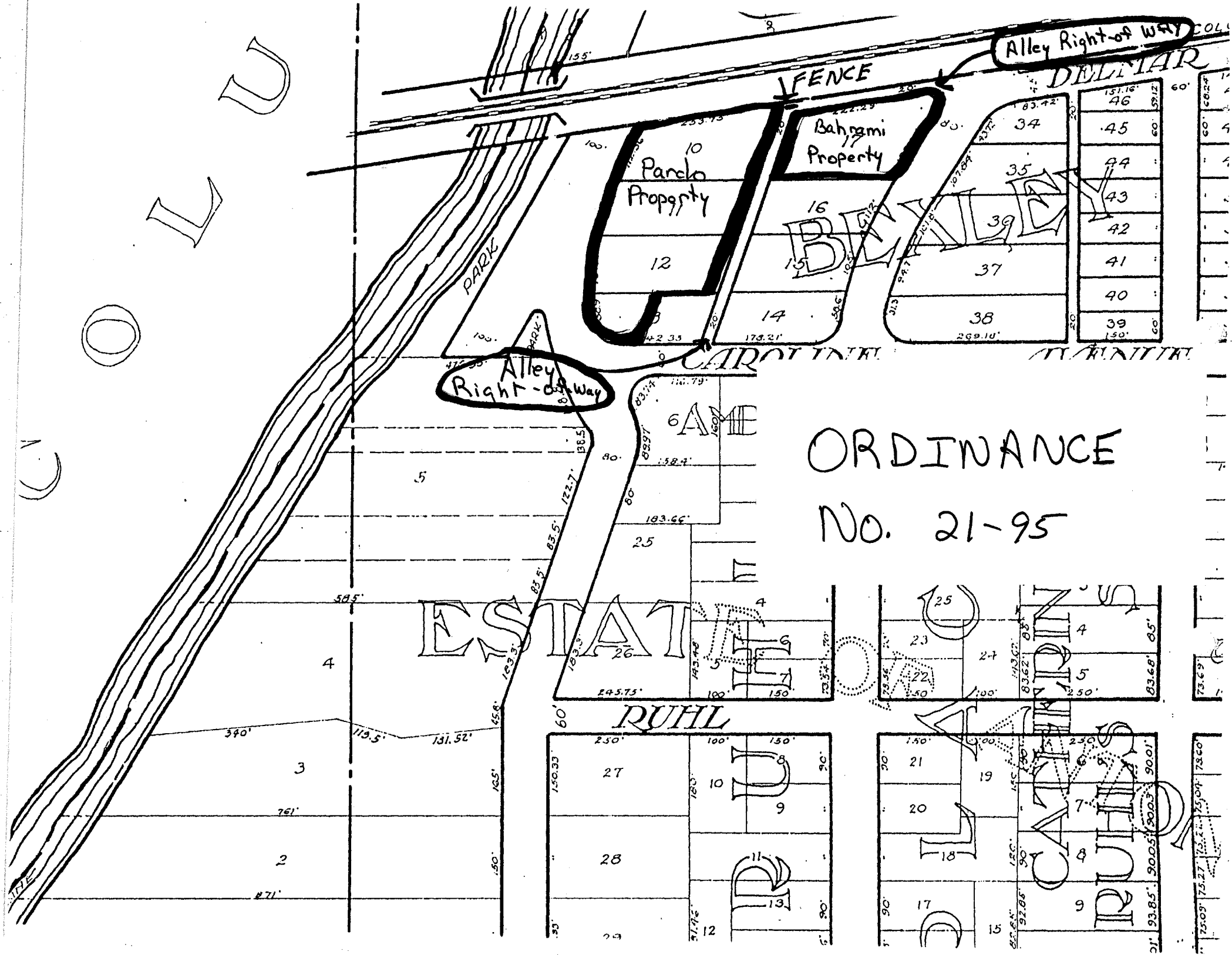
