

ORDINANCE NO. 52 -95

An Ordinance to authorize the Mayor and Auditor to execute an agreement with Nicki Chodnoff to act as public information consultant to the City.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the agreement between the City and Nicki Chodnoff is hereby approved in the form attached to this ordinance and that the Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement on behalf of the City.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety; said emergency being the necessity of enabling the City to implement a public information program on matters of public peace, health and safety at the earliest possible date, and shall be in force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.


CONTRACT

**BETWEEN THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO, and, NICKI CHODNOFF,
PUBLIC INFORMATION CONSULTANT,
HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS CONSULTANT**


WITNESSETH

- Section 1. Consultant shall, for the consideration hereinafter stated, furnish to the City public information consulting services as an independent contractor and not as an employee, to include: the preparation of news releases, news stories and other communications regarding the City and community activities and events; advice in developing a public information program for the City; assistance to City officials and employees in communicating with community organizations and the public; and the identification of public information opportunities.
- Section 2. Said services shall be furnished to the City through December 31, 1996, provided, however, that either party shall have the right to cancel this agreement upon ninety (90) days' written notice.
- Section 3. The City shall pay to Consultant for said services \$25.00 per hour, not to exceed the amount appropriated for this purpose for the calendar year 1995 and 1996.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties to this agreement have hereunto set their hands and seals and have executed this agreement this 27TH day of SEP, 1995.




