

ORDINANCE NO. 54-95

An Ordinance to appropriate \$37,000 from the Capital Improvements Fund to purchase two police cruisers and related equipment and to appropriate \$5,362.50 from the unencumbered General Fund to pay the legal fees of Baker & Hostetler, special counsel to Bexley City Council.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That \$37,000 is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvements Fund to purchase two (2) police cruisers and related equipment pursuant to the State of Ohio police vehicle purchasing program authorized by Section 125.04 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 2. That \$5,362.50 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund to pay the legal fees of Baker & Hostetler, special counsel to Bexley City Council.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
