

ORDINANCE NO. 58 -95

An Ordinance to appropriate \$1,650.00 from the unencumbered Capital Improvement Fund for the purchase of a tractor-driven rotary grass mower.

WHEREAS, the existing 1979 tractor-driven "belly" grass mower is unrepairable; and,

WHEREAS, it is necessary to have a tractor-driven grass mower to mow grass and mulch leaves in the City's large park areas. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That \$1,650.00 be, and the same hereby is, appropriated from the Capital Improvement Fund for the purchase of a tractor-driven rotary grass mower.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall go into force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
