An Ordinance to appropriate \$260.00 from the Unencumbered Water Fund for the purpose of testing water samples for the presence of lead and copper.

WHEREAS, \$1,000.00 was appropriated for the purpose of testing water samples for the presence of lead and copper; and,

WHEREAS, it was necessary to test six additional samples which requires an additional appropriation of \$260.00. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That \$260.00 should be, and hereby is, appropriated from the Unencumbered Water Fund for the purpose of testing water samples for the presence of lead and copper.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall go into force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
