An Ordinance to authorize the Mayor and Auditor to execute a Collective Bargaining Agreement with the Fraternal Order of Police, Capital City Lodge No. 9, with respect to a bargaining unit consisting of all full-time regular police officers in the rank of Sergeant and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized and directed to execute a Collective Bargaining Agreement with the Fraternal Order of Police, Capital City Lodge No. 9, with respect to a bargaining unit consisting of all fulltime regular police officers in the rank of Sergeant on the terms presented to this Council and in a form approved by the Bexley City Attorney, said agreement to be for the period January 1, 1996 through December 31, 1997.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the necessity of assuring uninterrupted benefits for members of the bargaining unit and shall go into force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
