## ORDINANCE NO. 74-95

An Ordinance to redesignate section (C)(17) of Section 262.02 of the Codified Ordinances as adopted by Substitute Ordinance No. 51-95 as "(D) Schedule II - Elected and Appointed Officials" and to amend subsections (1) and (2) thereof and to declare an emergency.

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

That section (C)(17) of Section 262.02 of the Codified Ordinances as adopted by Substitute Ordinance No. 78-95 is hereby amended to redesignate the section as "(D) Schedule II - Elected and Appointed Officials" and to amend subsections (1) and (2) as follows:

- Elected Officials. All elected officials shall be furnished health care insurance, dental care insurance, life insurance, and vision care insurance at the same benefit levels and coverage that is provided to Schedule I employees and such other insurance benefits, if any, as shall be mandated by state law; provided, however, that the Auditor and members of Council shall for 1996 pay \$1,391 of the premium cost for family coverage under the Basic Health Plan and \$695.50 of the premium cost of family coverage under the PPO. Compensation of Council members shall be as provided by the Charter, and compensation of the Mayor and Auditor shall be as provided by Ordinance.
- <u>City Attorney</u>. The City Attorney shall be furnished health care insurance, dental care insurance, life insurance, and vision care insurance at the same benefit levels, coverage and other terms that is provided to the Auditor and members of Council. Compensation shall be as provided by Ordinance.

That section (C)(17)(1) and (2) of Section 262.02 of the Section 2. Codified Ordinances as adopted by Substitute Ordinance No. 51-95 is hereby repealed.

That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for Section 3. the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to provide uninterrupted benefits for officials of the City, and shall be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor to be effective as of January 1, 1996.
