

ORDINANCE NO. 2-96

An Ordinance to appropriate \$711.59 from the unencumbered Capital Improvements Fund for the payment of bills related to the installation of a telephone line at Jeffrey Mansion and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the amount of \$711.59 should be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unencumbered Capital Improvements Fund for the payment of bills related to the installation of a telephone line at Jeffrey Mansion.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to provide payment for necessary services rendered after the closing of the City's 1995 fiscal year, but prior to the end of calendar year 1995, and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
