

ORDINANCE NO. 5- 96

An ordinance to appropriate \$5000.00 from the unencumbered Capital Improvements Fund for the purpose of increasing the memory in the computers and servers located in the Recreation Dept., Auditors Dept., Service Dept., Mayor's Office, Code Enforcement and to declare an emergency.

Whereas, the memory has not been upgraded since the purchase of the computers in 1994.

Whereas, it is necessary to increase the memory to run programs and maintain the City's records, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

That \$5000.00 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered Capital Improvements Fund for upgrading the City's computers.

That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
