
An Ordinance to appropriate \$1,700 from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of complying with the regulations of the Omnibus Transportation Act of 1991 to include policy development, required supervisor training and random drug and alcohol testing for holders of Commercial Drivers Licenses.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:


Section 1. That \$1,700 should be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of complying with the regulations of the Omnibus Transportation Act of 1991.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


