

ORDINANCE NO. 33 -96

An Ordinance to appropriate \$15,000 from the unencumbered Capital Improvements Fund for the purchase of one leaf vacuum machine to be used for the fall collection of leaves.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That \$15,000 should be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unencumbered Capital Improvements Fund for the purpose of purchasing one leaf vacuum machine.

Section 2. That the Mayor and Auditor should be, and hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into a contract for the purchase of one leaf vacuum machine.

Section 3. That the contract authorized herein will be in accordance with all applicable state and local laws.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall go into effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
