SUBSTITUTE ORDINANCE NO. 39-96

An Ordinance to amend Schedule I of Section 2 of Substitute Ordinance No. 50-95 for the purpose of changing the salary of the Police Chief for the period July 1, 1995, through June 30, 1996, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

<u>Section 1</u>. That Section 2 of Substitute Ordinance No. 50-95 is hereby amended at Schedule I to change the annual salary of the Police Chief for the period July 1, 1995, through June 30, 1996, as follows:

<u>Chief</u> \$114,048.83 (for services from July 1, 1995, to June 30, 1996) \$ 65,074.00 (for services from and after July 1, 1996)

<u>Section 2</u>. That the City shall reimburse Thomas W. Tobin, Jr. for health insurance premiums paid by him under the City's health insurance program from July 1, 1996 through December 31, 1996.

<u>Section 3</u>. That the portion of Ordinance No. 50-95 which is inconsistent with this Ordinance is hereby repealed, and all other portions of Ordinance No. 50-95 shall continue in full force and effect as amended hereby.

<u>Section 4</u>. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to adjust the salary of the Police Chief effective July 1, 1995, prior to the planned retirement of Thomas W. Tobin, Jr. as Chief on July 1, 1996, and shall go into force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
