An Ordinance consenting, pursuant to Section 723.04 of the Ohio Revised Code, to vacate the unnamed and unimproved alley and right-of-way lying between and parallel to vacated Parkview Avenue and Columbia Avenue north of Caroline Avenue.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

That the alley lying between vacated Parkview Avenue and Section 1. Columbia Avenue north of Caroline Avenue, which is unnamed and unimproved, is not used and has never been used by the City as a public alley, and will not be needed for any forseeable future need, and that the Planning Commission of the City reviewed and recommended that the alley be vacated and that such action will not be detrimental to the public interest.

Section 2. That the unnamed, unused alley described as follows:

A twenty foot strip, being so-called alley, lying to the east of Lot Nos. 10-13 and to the west of Lot Nos. 14-17 of the Bexley Heights Addition, and running from Caroline Avenue north 462.64 feet, more or less, terminating at the north corporation line of the City.

shall be, and the same hereby is, vacated and abandoned; provided, however, that the City of Bexley and all persons or companies engaging in the operation of public utilities shall retain, and have the right to maintain in place and to construct and erect, all sewers, conduits, pipes, poles and wires and any other facilities used or useful in the rendition of public utility service and the right of ingress and egress thereover.

That this Ordinance shall take effect and remain in force from and Section 3. after the earliest period allowed by law.
