

ORDINANCE NO. 65-96

An Ordinance to establish an encumbered fund to accept gifts and donations for the purpose of paying costs associated with the possible development of a Bexley community recreation center and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Auditor is authorized and directed to establish an encumbered fund to be designated the "Recreation Center Fund" to receive donations and monies from the public to pay costs incurred by the City in connection with the possible development of a Bexley community recreation center.

and/or independent citizens group

Section 2. That the expenditure of all monies deposited to the Recreation Center Fund shall be authorized by resolution or ordinance adopted by Council.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the necessity of paying certain costs associated with the development of a preliminary proposal for a proposed recreation center and shall be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
