	Section 2. That the expenditure of all monies deposited to the Recreation Center Fund shall be authorized by resolution or ordinance adopted by Council.

That this Ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the necessity of paying certain costs associated with the development of a preliminary proposal for a proposed recreation center and shall be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
