

ORDINANCE NO. 82 -96

An Ordinance to amend Section 452.15 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Bexley to include a restriction on the parking of vehicles on which there are signs advertising the sale of said vehicle.

Section 1. That Section 452.15 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Bexley be, and the same hereby is, amended to read as follows:

452.15 PARKING FOR ADVERTISING PURPOSES.

No vehicle to which is attached any advertising sign or placard not painted on the body thereof shall be parked on any street for a period longer than thirty minutes. NO VEHICLE TO WHICH IS ATTACHED A SIGN ADVERTISING THE SALE OF THE VEHICLE SHALL BE PARKED ON ANY PUBLIC OR PRIVATE PROPERTY FOR A PERIOD OF MORE THAN THIRTY MINUTES.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date permitted by law.
