

ORDINANCE NO. 2 -97

An Ordinance to appropriate \$1,867.32 from the unencumbered Capital Improvements Fund to pay Jess Howard Electric Company for the cost of furnishing materials and labor for the installation of flashing school zone signs.

WHEREAS, the amount of \$3,900.00 was appropriated by Ordinance No. -96 to pay Jess Howard Electric Company for the cost of furnishing materials and labor for the installation of flashing school zone signs; and,

WHEREAS, the work was not completed in time to bill during 1996 and the funds were not encumbered making it necessary to reappropriate the funds in 1997; and,

WHEREAS, the actual cost of the project was \$1,867.32. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the amount of \$1,867.32 should be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unencumbered Capital Improvements Fund to pay Jess Howard Electric Company for the cost of furnishing materials and labor for the installation of flashing school zone signs.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall go into effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
