

ORDINANCE NO. 6-97

An Ordinance to authorize the Mayor and Auditor to enter into a contract with the Ohio Association of Chiefs of Police, Inc. for consulting services in connection with the process for selecting a new Chief of Police, to appropriate \$6,300 from the unencumbered General Fund to fund such contract and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized and directed to enter into and execute, on behalf of the City, a contract with the Ohio Association of Chiefs of Police, Inc. for consulting services in connection with the process for selecting a new Chief of Police, said contract to be in the form attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Section 2. That \$6,300 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund to fund said contract.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to commence with the selection process at the earliest possible date and shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
