| WHEREAS, this Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the City to transfer a portion of the surplus funds in the Sewer Fund to the General Fund for the purpose of making a principal payment on certain outstanding construction notes of the City;                                       |

| Section 1. That \$70,000 is hereby transferred from the Sewer Fund to the unencumbered General Fund.   |
| Section 2. That \$70,000 is hereby transferred from the unencumbered General Fund to the Bond Retirement Fund.   |
| Section 3. That \$70,000 is hereby appropriated from the Bond Retirement Fund for the purpose of making a payment of principal on certain outstanding water distribution construction notes.   |
| Section 4. That this Ordinance shall go into effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.   |
