An Ordinance to appropriate \$10,000 from the unencumbered Water Fund and \$10,000 from the unencumbered Sewer Fund for the purpose of paying costs incurred in connection with upgrading the accounting and utility billing computer software in the Auditor's Office and the Water Department.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

<u>Section 1</u>. That account #09-365-1141, Computer Software, is hereby created and that \$10,000 is appropriated from the unencumbered Water Fund to this account for the purpose of paying costs to be incurred in connection with upgrading the accounting and utility billing software in the Auditor's Office and in the Water Department.

<u>Section 2</u>. That account #10-360-1141, Computer Software, is hereby created and that \$10,000 is appropriated from the unencumbered sewer fund to this account for the purpose of paying costs to be incurred in connection with upgrading the accounting and utility billing software in the Auditor's Office and the Water Department.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall go into effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
