

ORDINANCE NO. 12 -97

An Ordinance to authorize the Mayor and Auditor to enter into a contract with Ohio Leak Detection for the purpose of conducting a leak detection survey of main water lines, to appropriate \$10,000 from the unencumbered Water Fund to fund such contract and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized and directed to enter into and execute on behalf of the City a contract with Ohio Leak Detection, said contract to be in the form attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Section 2. That \$10,000 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund to fund said contract.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to determine the source of unmetered water usage and repair any leaks at the earliest possible date and shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
