

ORDINANCE NO. 22-97BY: Jeffrey L. McClelland

An Ordinance to establish rates of pay for all salaried employees, Parking Control Officer, Animal Control Officer, Police Chief, Police Lieutenant, Health Commissioner, Sanitarian, and Part-Time, Temporary and Casual employees of the City of Bexley, effective as of January 1, 1997, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the elected officials of the City of Bexley are to be paid in the manner prescribed by the Charter and Ordinances.

SCHEDULE I EMPLOYEES

Section 2. That all Schedule I employees will be paid 26 pays per year.

A. The Police Chief and Police Lieutenant will be paid as follows:

B. That all other full-time salaried employees (except elected officials) will be paid according to the following schedule:

When the Parking Control Officer is required by the Chief of Police to fulfill the duties of a dispatcher for a period of eight (8) or more consecutive hours, he/she will be compensated for the difference in pay.

Each of the employees in the foregoing positions on the effective date of this Ordinance will be paid the rate specified in the preceding schedule and all new hires will be placed in pay steps subject to the approval of City Council.

The Water Department Account Clerk 2 and the City Hall Secretary will be paid annual salaries based on the stated years of continuous employment in their respective positions as follows:

The Administrative Assistant to the Mayor will be paid on the anniversary date of hire to the position an annual salary based on the stated years of continuous employment in the position as follows:

The Assistant ~~Deputy Auditor~~ *Finance Director* will be paid on the anniversary date of hire to the position an annual salary based on the stated years of continuous employment in the position as follows:

The Code Enforcement Officer will be paid on the anniversary date of hire to the position an annual salary based on the stated years of continuous employment in the position as follows:

The Assistant Code Enforcement Officer will be paid on the anniversary date of hire to the position an annual salary based on the stated years of continuous employment in the position as follows:

The Senior Citizen Coordinator will be paid on the anniversary date of hire to the position an annual salary based on the stated years of continuous employment in the position as follows:

The Supervisor of Recreation #2 will be paid on the anniversary date of hire to the position an annual salary based on the stated years of continuous employment in the position as follows:

The Finance Director will be paid on the anniversary date of hire to the position an annual salary based on the stated years of continuous employment in the position as follows:

SCHEDULE II - ELECTED AND APPOINTED OFFICIALS

C. That the Health Commissioner and the Sanitarian will be paid as follows:

The Health Commission will be paid an annual salary of \$11,050. Such salary will be paid in 12 pays per year.

The Sanitarian will be paid an hourly rate of \$11.47 per hour, invoiced monthly to the City of Bexley, and benefits will be as set forth in the 1997 Benefits Ordinance.

That all part-time, temporary and casual employees other than salaried employees, will be paid according to Schedule III as follows:

Section 3. That ^{except as expressly provided in Schedule I of Section 2,} the provisions of this Ordinance shall take effect as of January 1, 1997.

Section 4. That, until and unless changed, the hours of work, working conditions and fringe benefits of all employees of the City of Bexley shall be set forth in the 1997 Benefits Ordinance.

Section 5. That in order to assure uninterrupted City services, this Ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and this Ordinance shall go into force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
