An Ordinance to appropriate ~~\$67,205.00~~ from the Capital Improvements Fund for various capital improvements during the fiscal year ending December 31, 1997, and to authorize contracts therefor in accordance with law.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That \$67,205.00 is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvements Fund for the following purposes:
