

ORDINANCE NO. 35 -97

An Ordinance to appropriate \$6,000.00 from the unencumbered General Fund for the payment of expenses in connection with moving the emergency warning signal from City Hall to the Bexley School District property on South Cassingham Road.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That \$6,000.00 hereby is appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying expenses to be incurred in connection with moving the emergency warning signal from City Hall to the Bexley School District property on South Cassingham Road.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall go into effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
