

ORDINANCE NO. 39 -97

An Ordinance to establish an encumbered fund to be designated the "Bexley Recreation Donation Rotary Fund" to accept gifts and donations for the purpose of paying costs associated with City recreation programs, to appropriate money from such fund when and as received from time to time by the City, and to appropriate \$1,225.00 donated to support recreation programs and deposited in the unencumbered General Fund to Account #05-520-132.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Auditor is authorized and directed to establish an encumbered fund to be designated the "Bexley Recreation Donation Rotary Fund" to receive contributions from the public to support programs of the City Recreation Department.

Section 2. That all money deposited to the Bexley Recreation Donation Rotary Fund is hereby appropriated, when and as received, to pay the costs of City Recreation Department programs and that the Mayor or his designee is authorized to make expenditures from such Fund for recreation purposes as determined by him or her from time to time to the extent that money is available in such Fund.

Section 3. That \$1,225, donated to support the City Recreation Department and deposited in the unencumbered General Fund, is hereby appropriated to Account #05-520-132 to pay current operating expenses of the Recreation Department.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall go into effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
